Dear Families,

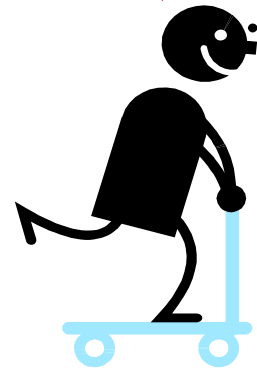
Our **Reading Raffle** with special prizes went to those who've read
