Education Maintenance Allowance

Some years ago changes were made to the Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA) and instead of the total payment going to parents, half was paid directly to the school where the children of eligible parents were enrolled. Two years ago the schools portion of EMA ceased to be paid and **from 2015 the parents portion of EMA will cease to be paid**. In the past many families have had their EMA paid directly to the school to be used to cover costs for camps, excursions and other activities—from next year other arrangements will need to be made in regard to these payments.
