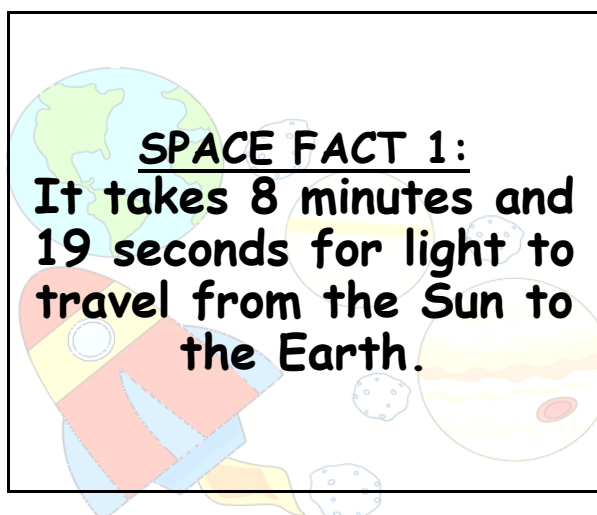
We also discussed the consequences for disrespecting our values, as School Council suggested a note will go home for parents to sign and return, describing the student's behaviour.

If you bring cash to school to make a payment please ensure you have the correct money as we do not keep cash at school for change.

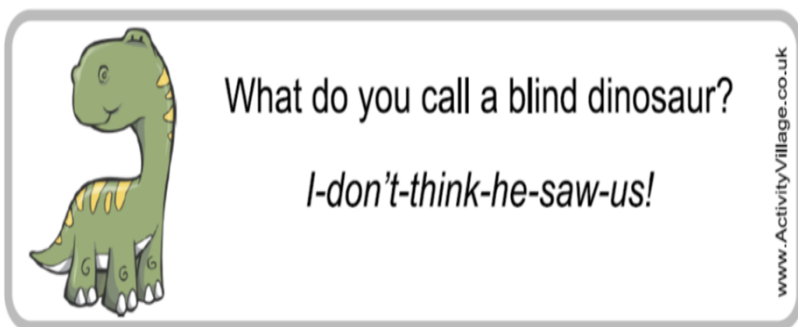
### School Banking
