We will also begin our performing arts practices in earnest for the end of the year Presentation Night.



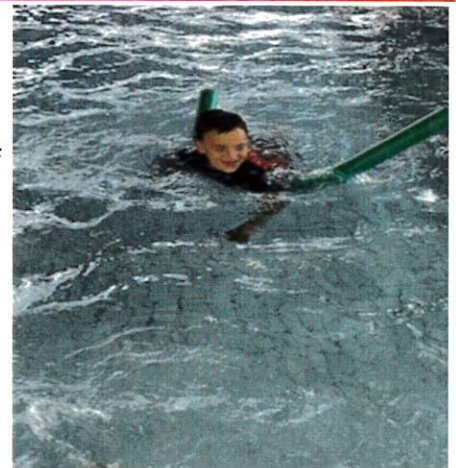

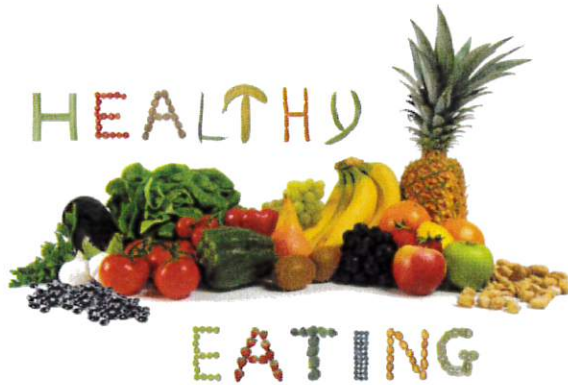

**Remember everyday is important, if your child can't come to school, please let us know. (It is now a Department of Education requirement for families to be contacted when a child is absent without explanation).**

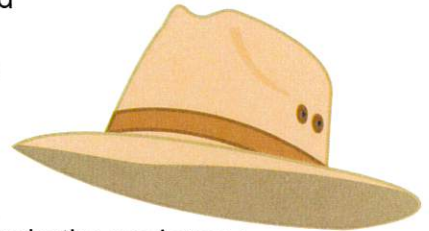
