Dear Families,

Attached is another copy of the Drought Response Package application form. While you may feel that your family and children do not need this support, you are encouraged to apply. As this support is offered through the State Schools Relief organisation, all the items sourced will help State Schools Relief in their support of other families now and in the future.

Package 1 is for uniform items alone, package 2 is for a reduced uniform package plus a \$100 voucher which the school will credit against any school costs for your child/ren in 2019 and package 3 is similar to package 2 but with less uniform items and a \$200 voucher towards your child's school costs.

Each package includes windcheaters. These are a discontinued item of ONPS uniform and only a limited number are available.

Each package provides for shoes. Please ensure you make use of the shoe sizing chart available in the office when making your application so the correct size shoes are supplied.

Some of the uniform items are supplied direct by State Schools Relief and your application will need to include size required for these items—Skorts or shorts, dress, socks (SSS, XSM or LXL), parka and track pants (and, as above, shoes).

Thank you to those who have already completed application forms, however please drop in to the office with your child to use the shoe sizing chart if you have not done so already to make sure the correct size is provided.

# **DROUGHT RESPONSE PACKAGE TO ASSIST FAMILIES IN NEED**

The Victorian Government has announced a one-off commitment of \$2.2 million to help families in the drought affected local government areas of Wellington and East Gippsland with the cost of uniforms, shoes and other school items.

This support is being made available through State Schools' Relief (SSR), which has been providing assistance with uniforms to government school students since 1931.

Families can choose **one** of the following three packages for **each child** at this school:

- Package 1: uniform package **OR**
- Package 2: reduced uniform package plus textbooks voucher to the value of \$100 **OR**
- Package 3: limited uniform package plus textbooks voucher to the value of \$200.

The contents of each of the three package are itemised in the attached information sheet.

## **What should families do to access this support?**

To make a request for this support, families should:

- Review the contents of the packages in the attached information sheet
- Select which one of the packages they would like for each child
- Mark the size for each child
- Provide the details requested and sign the request form where indicated
- Return the information sheet with the signed request form to school.

## **What schools will do**

- School will process families' requests via SSR
- SSR will send a voucher for the package indicating where it can be redeemed to school
- School will advise families when the voucher is available for collection.

## **Please note:**

SSR advises that families receiving vouchers may be required to make a co-contribution towards the cost of uniform items for their children.

The amount of any co-contribution from families will depend on the difference between the value of the SSR voucher and the retail price of uniform items purchased.

The amount on the voucher is the maximum value of SSR's co-contribution.

Families should check the school's uniform price list to see how much their co-contribution towards the purchase of the uniform items will be.

## DROUGHT RESPONSE PACKAGE – REQUEST FORM FOR PRIMARY SCHOOLS

Families receiving vouchers may be required to make a co-contribution towards the cost of uniform items for their children. The amount of any co-contribution from families will depend on the difference between the value of the SSR voucher and the retail price of uniform items purchased. The amount on the voucher is the maximum value of SSR's co-contribution.

Families should check the school's uniform price list to see how much their co-contribution towards the purchase of the uniform items will be.

The choice of package and the contents of packages cannot be altered after this form has been signed and returned to school.
