



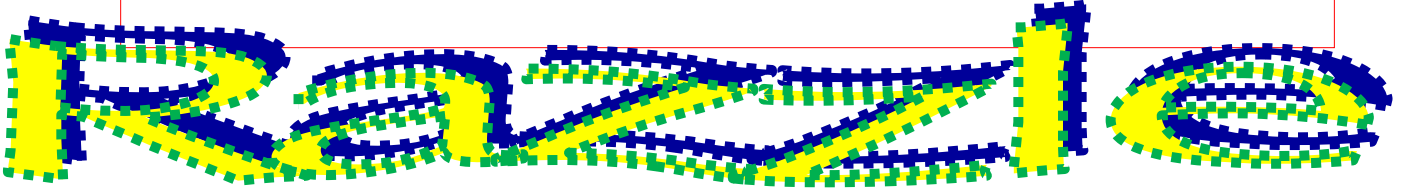

It's also pleasing to see so many students hooking into Mathletics in their own time, seven students attained Bronze certificates yesterday for their hard work!

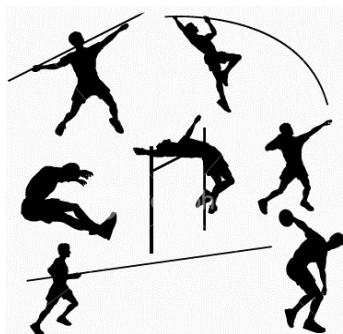
Don't forget the annual Department of Education's **Parent Survey**, which needs to be

We are looking forward to seeing some new smiling faces tomorrow at our "Let's Play Schools".



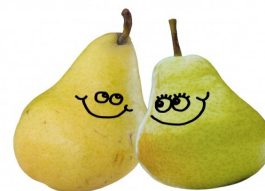
Finally we'd like to wish the Crause family farewell and all the best for their time in New Zealand and we look forward to their return next year with their new addition!
