



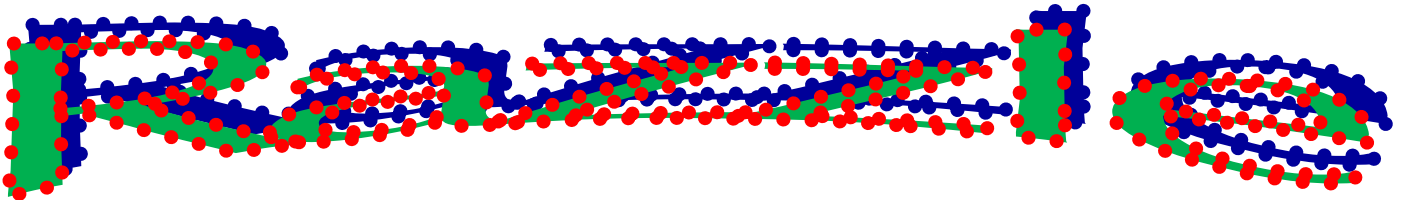

Sporting Schools is running on Monday and Wednesday afternoons this term and two lunch times a week.

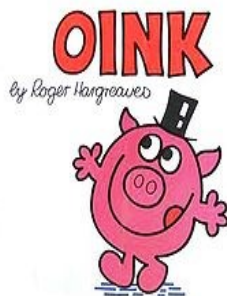
