School banking day for students is on Tuesday. Congratulations to those students receiving saver awards.

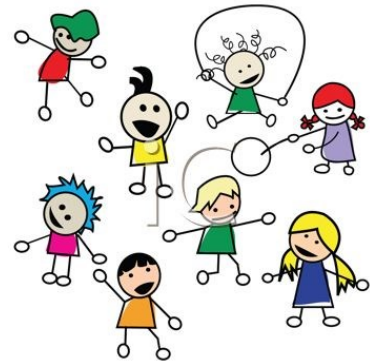
